The course will run **online over four weeks** using a Canvas learning management system and will include extensive resources.

Each week you will have access to **a one-hour pre-recorded lecture** (broken into chunks), using real-world examples that relate to CBCA Book of the Year Award categories and criteria, **plus** four one hour Zoom webinars to discuss weekly topics, and (**NEW in 2024**) a breakout discussion group for each State for 30 minutes. (2.5 hours per week total)

Zoom webinars and breakout session will be held on Thursdays (May 16- June 6) @ 6pm-7.30 pm AEST.

MAY 23 WEEK 2 Engaging the reader — developing aesthetic appreciation of picture books, novels and non-fiction

MAY 30 WEEK 3 Responding to literature — building critical awareness through close reading and paying attention to literary language

JUNE 6 WEEK 4 Choosing quality literature— how to find quality literature and why does quality matter?
