- 1. The CBCA NSW Branch Inc Aspiring Writers Mentorship Program is a mentorship only.
- 2. The program is open to all Australian citizens residing in Australia.
- 3. The open date for entries is 1 July, 2024. The closing date for entries is 2 September, 2024. Entries received after the closing date will not be considered.
- 4. Entrants must not be a published writer of a picture book, poem, fiction, non-fiction book/s, or play script published by a commercial publisher or under contract with a commercial publisher, or self-published.
- 5. Manuscripts entered **MUST NOT** be previously published.
 - Published is defined as: <u>published online</u>; <u>self-published</u>; <u>under contract for publication</u>; <u>published by a commercial company</u>;
- 6. Manuscripts entered must be the entrant's own work and must be in English.
- 7. Previous Frustrated/Aspiring Writers Mentorship **winners** may not re-enter. Previous Shortlisted entrants may re-enter and submit a new or revised manuscript/s.
- 8. Only full manuscripts will be accepted. Entrants **MUST NOT** put their name or contact details anywhere in the manuscript or it will be automatically disqualified.
- 9. Entrants must upload the **entry form found on CBCA NSW** Branch Inc website. This form includes provision for the **2024 support document & manuscript to** be uploaded.

The files uploaded in this form should be saved in the following format: the manuscript: man-_your initials_title eg man_GE_The Story of a Dog the support form: sup_your initials eg sup_GE

If submitting multiple manuscripts, one entry form per manuscript needs to be completed.

- 11. Manuscripts will not be returned.
- 12. Manuscripts will be blind judged.
- 13. The Shortlist and Winner will be announced by CBCA NSW Branch Inc as part of the Aspire & Celebrate end of year event.
- 14. **The Winner** receives the **Cottesloe Mentorship** which consists of 5 hours with Cathie Tasker (face to face) and the Charlotte Waring Certificate. No accommodation or travel forms part of this prize.
- 15. The 2 Shortlisted authors will each receive a copy of *How to be an author* by Georgia Richter & Deborah Hunn plus access to *The Business of Being a Writer Seminar* provided by Fremantle Press.
- 16. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. No individual feedback or comments will be given.
- 17. The CBCA NSW Branch Inc reserves the right not to award a mentorship at the judges' discretion.
